Dr. Peter Angelides is Vice President and Director of Econsult Corporation. He is an economist who provides economic and financial analysis and advice to clients in both consulting and litigation contexts, and his clients, including private companies, law firms, and local and state governments, span a wide variety of industries. He has over fifteen years of experience in economic consulting and in the planning and development community.

Prior to joining Econsult, he held the position of Director in the Philadelphia office of PricewaterhouseCoopers, where he calculated damages, defended patents, and assessed royalty rates in a variety of intellectual property and general litigation cases. For governments, he evaluated market competitiveness and estimated the economic impacts from private investment, and for private clients he set prices for intellectual property, evaluated the impact of technology licensing agreements, and constructed and analyzed complex models. Dr. Angelides previously worked with Charles River Associates and Putnam Hayes & Bartlett (later PHB Hagler Bailly) in Washington DC, where he assisted clients in merger and rate-setting proceedings before the Department of Justice, the Federal Trade Commission, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, and the Postal Rate Commission. He also provided litigation assistance to clients in the telecom, energy and pharmaceutical sectors.

Dr. Angelides has held planning and development related positions at Wallace Roberts and Todd, the Central Philadelphia Development Corporation, the Greater Philadelphia Economic Development Corporation, and the Philadelphia City Planning Commission. In these roles, he participated in the preparation of environmental impact statements for the Washington DC Metrorail system, the preparation of WRT's first GIS based land use plan, the preparation of the 1988 Plan for Center City, and the formation of the Center City District.

Dr. Angelides is also a Lecturer in the Urban Studies program in the University of Pennsylvania. He teaches the economic analysis of contemporary urban issues—such as the impact of tax policy and the role of municipal government in the local economy. In addition, he has taught a variety of economics courses at the University of Minnesota, including cost-benefit analysis, microeconomics, and international trade and payments.

Dr. Angelides received his Bachelor of Arts in Urban Studies, with honors, and Master of City Planning degrees from the University of Pennsylvania and his M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in economics from the University of Minnesota.
