Carolyn H. Nichols, Esq. is a Senior Advisor of Econsult Corporation. Ms. Nichols attended Temple University and graduated with Bachelor of Fine Arts, Juris Doctor, and Master of Laws in Trial Advocacy degrees. From 1991 to 1995, Ms Nichols served in municipal government as an attorney for several City agencies. Ms Nichols was named General Counsel for the Philadelphia Parking Authority from 1999 to 2005, and served as Deputy Secretary of External Affairs in the Philadelphia's Mayor's Office during 2005 and 2006. The Mayor appointed her as Deputy Finance Director and Director of the Minority Business Enterprise Council from 2006 through 2008. As MBEC Director, she was responsible to oversee the implementation of the City's programs to promote the economic development of minority, woman and disabled owned businesses in City contracting, including certification, outreach, preparation of disparity studies, compliance monitoring, and reporting. In 2002, Ms Nichols received a Master of Business Administration degree from Eastern University. In 2007 and 2008, she was one of the leaders awarded the Philadelphia Tribune's Most Influential African Americans award.
